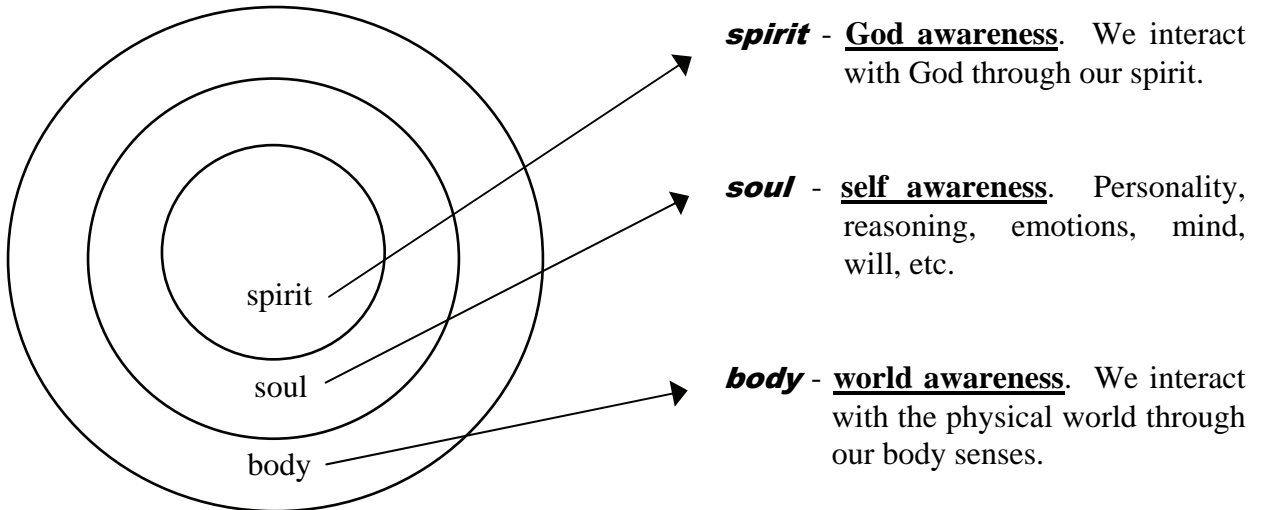


THE SPIRITUAL ANATOMY OF A CHRISTIAN

1. Man was a unique creation of God, set apart from the rest of His creation. Man alone was given a “spirit”, through which he can know God.

Then the Lord God formed man of dust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being. Genesis 2:7



1 Thess. 5:23 *Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you entirely; and may your spirit and soul and body be preserved complete, without blame at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.*

Rom. 8:16 *The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God,*

1 Cor. 14:15 (Paul wrote) ... *I will pray with the spirit and I will pray with the mind also; I will sing with the spirit and I will sing with the mind also.*

NOTE FOR THE DISCIPLER: The above diagram is a simple transitional tool to be used until the more complex biblical model of the temple is presented in Lesson 3-12.

2. The entire animal kingdom is limited in scope, without a “spirit”, and thus without an awareness of God. (Gen. 2:7 refers to man alone)
